We are pleased to announce the third round of Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) funding under the San Francisco Bay Water Quality Improvement Fund (SFBWQIF) is now **OPEN**.

The BIL-SFBWQIF FY 2024-2025 notice of funding opportunity (NOFO) is funding from Congress to build resiliency in underserved communities. Proposed projects must be within the nine Bay Area counties that

drain to San Francisco Bay. Applications must be submitted through

Grants.gov

on or before the submission deadline of

April 17, 2025 at 9:00pm Pacific Standard Time.

Under this BIL-SFBWQIF NOFO, EPA is accepting applications for approximately \$14 million in grant funding to support projects in the range of ~\$500,000 to \$2 million to improve environmental and public health benefits for communities with environmental justice concerns. There is
