## Subject: CEQA Support Services for CAL FIRE Grant-funded Project – Amendment 1

Dear Ms. Moreno,

With this letter, Ascent is requesting an increase in budget for out-of-scope services needed to provide CEQA support services for the North Santa Clara Resource Conservation District's (RCD's) Hazardous Fuel Reduction Program (CAL FIRE Grant Agreement No. 5GA21155). The original scope assumed that the project area would be up to 20,000 acres with 500 acres of priority treatment, and the project is now calculated to be 28,069.6 acres with 6,258.9 acres of priority treatment area. Additional budget is being requested to extend the analysis into these additional acres. ARC also requests additional funding to account for additional mapping to identify shaded versus non-shaded fuel break acres for the PSA analysis, and to consider three different buffer sizes to calculate the acres of area affected by ball and chain treatment activity. Finally, Ascent is requesting additional budget to support increased project management support and team communication. Since project kickoff, it has become evident that, in the interest of project success, more coordination than was assumed in the original budget is necessary to keep all parties continuously apprised of project status and issues. This will be delivered through one-hour biweekly meetings between October 7<sup>th</sup> and March 15<sup>th</sup> as well as direct email and phone communication with the RCD and CAL FIRE when needed (within the identified budget parameters). In total, Ascent and ARC request a combined budget increase of \$11,900 to accommodate these changes. Please see the attached cost breakdown for more information.
