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1. Call to Order:

1.1 The meeting was called to order by President Hare. Directors present: President Hare, Vice President Bautista, and Directors Maitiski and Quintero (arrived at 5:38 p.m.). Executive staff present: Executive Director/District Clerk Moreno and District Counsel Gantenbein.

1.2 Vote on request by Director Quintero to participate in the meeting virtually under the just cause provisions of the Brown Act.

Motion: Approve the request by Director Quintero to participate in the meeting virtually under the just cause provisions of the Brown Act. (Hare/Bautista; 3-0-0)

2. Meeting Agenda:

Motion: Approve the agenda as presented. (Hare/Maitiski; 4-0-0)

3. Public Comment at a Special Meeting – Matters not on the Agenda: None

4. Director Appointment Process Update:

4.1 The Board received a report from District Counsel regarding PRC section 9314 and the County Board of Supervisors authority to appoint a successor within 60 days of an unscheduled vacancy.

4.2 The Board received a report from NSCRCD President of activities subsequent to May 2, 2024 NSCRCD Board Meeting.

4.3 The Board discussed the appointment process for the unscheduled vacancy consistent with PRC sections 9314, 9316, and agreed that even though they did not appear to have appointing authority at this time, to proceed with an informational interview of Candidate #4 in order to treat this candidate as fairly and equally as possible, given that the other three candidates were interviewed together at the May 2, 2024 meeting. At this point, Director Maitiski acknowledged that Candidate #4 had asked him to be a reference, so in the interest of avoiding any concern being raised regarding the appearance of any potential conflict given he may also be making the appointment decision, he stepped out of the room for the duration of Candidate #4's interview.

Directors were asked to ask the candidate the same questions they asked in the previous interviews, and they proceeded to interview Candidate #4.

At the conclusion of the interview, Director Maitiski returned to the meeting, and after discussion, the Board took the following action:

Motion: Defer considering action to make an appointment within 60 days of the date of unscheduled vacancy created by former Director McColl's resignation. (Hare/Quintero; 4-0-0)
